



Roll the Dice!

Object - Remove all 12 of your chips from the game board as quickly as possible

Set-up

Each player starts with 12 chips. Place the 12 chips on your game board on any numbers you want. You can place any number of chips on any square

Strategy

Before you begin the game, read the rules carefully and explain your strategy on the back of your tally sheet. After you place your chips on the board and describe your strategy, begin the game.

Rules

- Each player takes turns and rolls two dice.
- Add the sum of each roll and every player removes ONE chip from that number on your board if you have chips on that number on your board
- Next player rolls and again, remove a chip from your board if you have a chip on that number.
- Every player records the rolls of each player on the tally sheet. All tally sheets should all have identical data at the end of each round and at the end of each game.
- Continue rolling the dice until all chips are removed from one player's board – the Winner!

Play!

Tally Sheet

Keep track of each roll of every player. For example, if a player rolls a 7, EVERYONE put one \surd next to 7.
Keep track of every roll for every player!
